of workers toggle between apps up to 10x an hour.









Step 1: Home Office Equipment Procedure?






Step 2: Ordering a New Chair





Leverage no-code development to enable business teams to optimize the employee experience




No-Code On the Rise

75% of large enterprises will use at least four low-code development tools by 2024 (ZDNet)

By 2024, **80%** of technology products and services will be built by those who are not technology professionals (Gartner)
